<p>THE BCC PURPOSE: To provide a forum for the discussion and review of issues of interest relating to or concerning Brentwood to Stakeholders, Geographical Zone Organizations, and Special [i.e.topical] Interests [such as Transportation, Safety, and Environmental issues]; To be an advocate for Brentwood to governmental and private agencies upon those issues relating to or concerning Brentwood that the BCC selects; To assist and serve as an advisory body to governmental entities and persons by making findings and recommendations on issues relating to or concerning Brentwood; assist other organizations in Brentwood desiring help with their objectives or projects relating to or concerning Brentwood that the BCC chooses to support; To assist in developing and enhancing the sense of community in Brentwood, and, to engage in such other activities relating to or concerning Brentwood as are allowed by law.</p>	<p>Per Article V, Section 5 of the BCC Bylaws: “The presiding officer [Chair or Vice Chair] may limit the total amount of time allocated to a particular issue and to each individual speaker. To the extent practicable, the conduct of meetings shall be governed by Roberts Rules of Order...” to allow for respectful dialogue; Agenda and meeting management are at the discretion of the BCC Chair.</p>	<p>Public Comment The BCC welcomes public comment and has a 20 year history of incorporating community input into our positions and policies. Per Roberts Rules, public comment shall be limited to the issue at hand and not meant to inflame, subject persons to ridicule or disrupt the proceedings of the meeting. Behavior that violates these points of order will be subject to warnings, removal from meeting and/or Board motion for censure, including removal from future BCC meetings.</p>
